



# Yoto Player Setup Checklist

A quick-start guide for busy grown-ups



## What You'll Need:

- Yoto Player or Yoto Mini
- USB-C charging cable and plug
- Smartphone or tablet
- Wi-Fi connection
- Yoto App (Apple/Google Play)
- Yoto Cards



## Step-by-Step Setup

### 1. Download the Yoto App

- Open your app store
- Search for “Yoto” and install
- Create or log in to your Yoto account

### 2. Plug In and Power Up

- Connect the Yoto Player to power
- For Yoto Mini, hold the orange button until the screen lights up
- Wait for any software updates to install

### 3. Pair the Player with the App

- Open the Yoto App, go to ‘Settings’ and tap ‘Set up a player’
- Follow the prompts to connect via Bluetooth and Wi-Fi
- Your player should now be available in the app

### 4. Insert a Yoto Card

- Slide a card into the top of the player
- Wait for it to download
- Adjust volume using orange knobs

### 5. Explore the Yoto App

- Try Yoto Daily
- Browse sleep sounds, music & more
- Set wake-up and sleep timers
- Explore Make Your Own (MYO) card options

### 6. Optional Extras

- Set up a bedtime routine
- Tap top of Yoto Player for night light (not on Mini)
- Record your own content with a MYO card
- Join the Yoto Space parent community



## Not Working - Keep Your Head!

I've set up lots of Yoto Players and Yoto Minis over the years and from time to time I've had a little trouble getting the Yoto to connect to WiFi. Here are a few tips to try. Just repeat the steps again including switching the player off and then back on (this often works). Get closer to the router if you can. If still not working walk away and try again in half an hour! Yes, this has worked so many times! Still having problems then it's worth trying the set up on a different WiFi network (eg. friends/ family).
