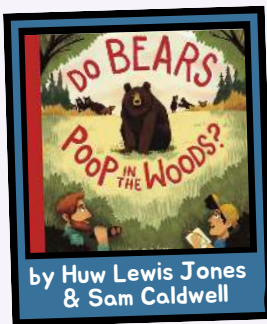
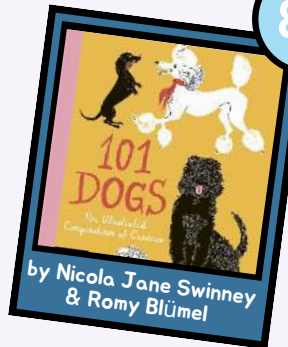
An Arctic Story is a epic delight to the North Pole and back. A seasonally cyclic story intertwining fiction and non-fiction.

A moving middle grade read *The Night Animals* promises to touch your soul and with Sharon King-Chai's illustrations it's a beauty too.

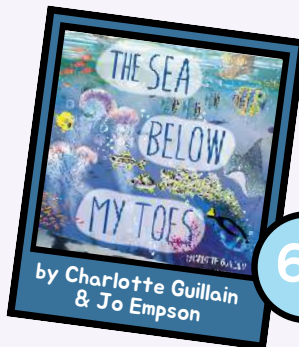

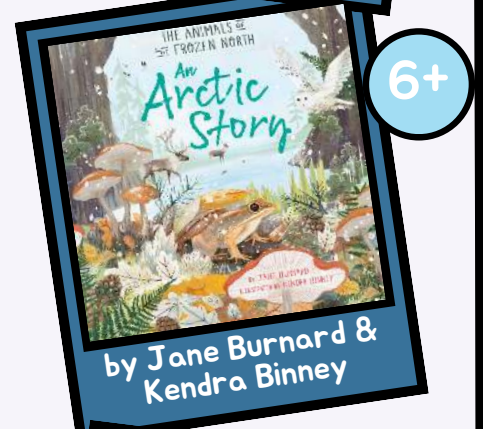


Fun and fact filled with oodles of information about a variety of bears. This would make a great pairing with a bear picture book.

You can't help but fall in love with Gertie from The Littlest Yak and the latest adventure The New Arrival.

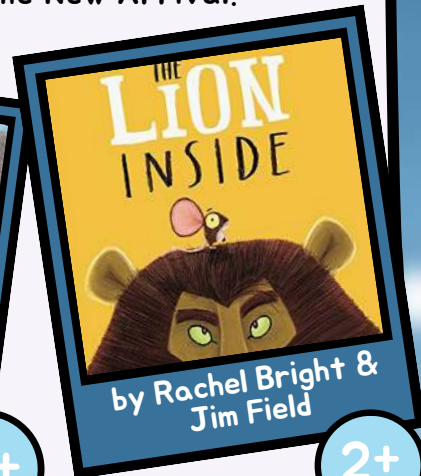
