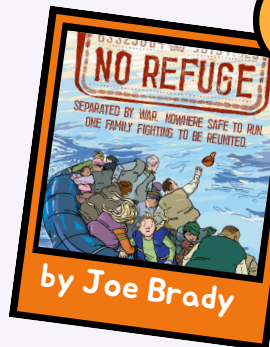


Bookworm Buzz

A warm story about finding balance, comfort, and courage.

Sisters Bea and Hannah are on the run with their baby brother, fleeing war and searching for safety. A gripping, empathy-filled comic about courage, survival, and the power of family.
