The Insiders will have readers gripped in the challenging world of friendships. Secrets, lies and being on the inside or outside!

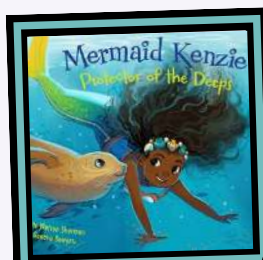
Water World

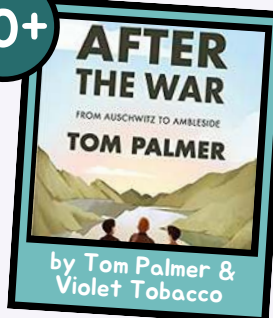
