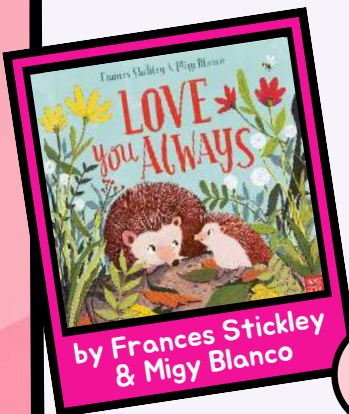
Love is in the Air

The Kiss gives you two books in one - a story told from both ends that come together in the perfect family blend in the middle - adorable.

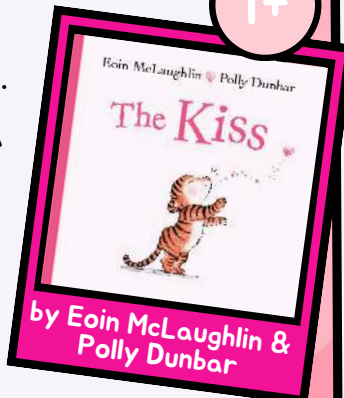
Love You Always takes you through seasonal changes and it has little Hoglet wondering if Mummy's love will change if he changes. Hoglet soon learns that some things never change.

Wherever You Are My Love Will Find You is a wonderful book to reassure little ones just how much they are loved and that love knows no distances and will travel to wherever you are.



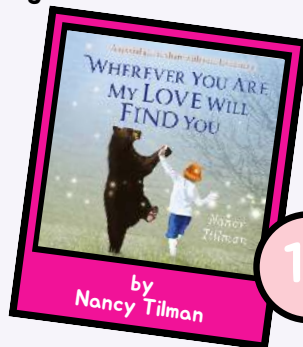
